Classroom Volunteers

Work regularly with classroom teachers. They assist students and help with projects and field trips.

Time Commitment: During the school day, average, of one hour per week.

Schools: Elementary, Middle and Exceptional Student Education Centers.

Training: Provided by location.

I'm Thumbody Volunteers

Present a short self-esteem building program to second graders. Activities help students value their own unique qualities and abilities.

Time Commitment: During the school day, average of one hour per week.

Schools: Elementary Only

Training: Provided by Mental Health Association

Meet the Masters Volunteers

Show and discuss art prints in elementary classes. Trained volunteers lead student discussions about the artists' styles and lives.

Time Commitment: During the school day, average of one hour per week.

Schools: Elementary

Training: Provided by Volunteer Services.

Mentors

Serve as positive role models for students who need motivation to stay in school. Mentors offer a listening ear and encouragement.

Time Commitment: During the school day, one hour per week for one semester.

Schools: Elementary, Middle and High

Training: Two-hour required training

Read Aloud Volunteers

Inspire students to be readers by helping them learn to appreciate stories and books.

Time Commitment: During the school day, average of one hour per week.

Schools: Elementary

Training: Provided by location.

Special Activity Volunteers

Help with a specific project at a school or at a district office. Projects include: curriculum fairs, student competitions, screenings and productions.

Training: Depends on the activity.

Schools: Elementary, Middle and High

Time Commitment: Depends on the activity, usually short-term & intensive.

SuperStars Volunteers

Work with a math enrichment program designed to sharpen students' thinking and problem solving skills.

Time Commitment: May be done after the school day, depending on school.

Schools: Elementary Only

Training: Provided by location.

Volunteer Tutors

Give students extra help with academic subjects, especially at the middle and high school levels.

Time Commitment: During the school day, average of one hour per week.

Schools: Elementary, Middle and High

Training: Provided by the teacher.
